Section 35 - Aboriginal Peoples

- (1) The existing aboriginal and treaty rights of the aboriginal people in Canada are hereby recognized and affirmed.
- (2) In this act "Aboriginal Peoples of Canada" includes the Indian, Inuit, and Métis Peoples of Canada.
